

\$1.2 Million Upgrade in new MRI Equipment at Navarro Regional



Corsicana, TX — On Oct. 24 the new Phillips Achieva 16 channel Magnetic Resonance Imaging Unit (MRI) was delivered to be installed at Navarro Regional Hospital.

In order to remove the existing MRI and have the new one installed, a large portion of an exterior wall was temporarily removed.

“This new MRI brings us the latest technology in medical imaging,” says Jack Wepler, director of diagnostic imaging services. “This investment represents the hospital’s commitment to advancing diagnostic care for our patients and physicians.”

The new \$1.2 million MRI is expected to be available for patient studies at the end of November. In the meantime, a mobile MRI unit is available in addition to the Open MRI unit located on Second Ave.
